The events/activities must have community wide appeal and be based around Youth, Sports, Concerts, Community BBQ, Health and Wellbeing Events, Arts and Culture, Children's Families, and Senior's Events to benefit the Roebourne community. APPLICATION INFORMATION

1. Only 50% of funding will be provided up-front.
2. Submissions must be received 8 weeks prior to your event.
3. Organisations who do not acquit their grant within 8 weeks of event completion (including the return of acquittal documentation and forms) may have their funding retracted and will not be eligible for funding in the next rounds.
4. Receipts MUST be provided when claiming reimbursement of funds, and acquitting grant. A valid tax invoice will be required as well. We can not pay on supporting receipts only.
